What file types should I send?

For PRL Reporting Software Options A and C, your report is contained in text files (extension .txf). For Option D, report data is in Microsoft Excel files (extension .x/s or .x/sx).

If you upload files through the website, your files may include text files (extension .txt), Microsoft Excel workbooks (extension .xls or .xlsx), and "zipped" file collections (extension .zip).



If your Windows computer is not set up to display file extensions, use your mouse to right-click on the file. Choose **Properties**. The extension is listed on the "General" tab in the **Files of Type** field.



Even for text files, if your files are not <u>formatted</u> according to the <u>Text File Specifications</u> we might not be able to process them. Report submissions containing files that do not meet our file <u>specifications</u> may be rejected.

Option A files and files that passed validation in Option A comply with the specifications if you have followed the file naming convention.
